## CARING FOR YOUR WATER COOLER

With spring in the air, now is a good time to refresh your cooler. Here are some handy instructions for keeping your cooler fresh and clean (just like your *Spring Alive* water).

Switch off the cooler at the power point and remove the plug from the wall socket. Remove the bottle and the lid from the cooler. Different cooler models have various lid configurations. Please contact us if you have any difficulty removing the lid.

Drain the water out of the bowl through the tap/s. If your cooler has a heat bowl there will be a drain plug located at the rear of the unit. To drain heat bowl remove the plug and plastic circlip (a metal ring sprung into a slot to hold it in place). Some cooler drain plugs will have a screw cap. This will need to be removed to drain completely. In some coolers you will need to remove the baffle that separates cool/chilled water.

Flush with clean spring water to remove residues. Fill the bowl with a weak solution of organic acid (spring water and vinegar 25:1) and clean cooler and lid with a clean plastic scouring pad. Alternatively Cooler Clean Spray or Cooler Clean Rinse could be used. Place the lid into the solution to sanitise it. Drain and flush with Spring Water.

To ensure cooler is free of any debris, wash cooler again using spring water and re-drain. Repeat process until totally clean.

Refit the lid to the top of the cooler and install a new bottle of *Spring Alive* Energised spring water. Plug in cooler and switch it on again. It is now ready for use.

Note: *Spring Alive* can supply Cooler Clean Rinse for \$25 per 500ml bottle or Cooler Clean Spray for \$15 per 100ml bottle.
